


Rules for the Student Code of Conduct and fines for their violation

Recently different students' disciplinary issues were observed which are projecting a very negative image of the CUI Vehari-Campus. To prevent such incidents from occurring in the future a code of conduct for students is developed by the Campus Proctorial Board. All the Departments (DOOs and Batch advisors) must communicate these rules to their respective departmental students on an urgent basis. The reputation of the campus is a top priority so all the students violating these rules will be strictly penalized and punished according to the nature of the offense.

1. It is compulsory for students to always keep their ID cards with them. Students without ID cards are not allowed to attend their classes. Class teachers must ensure that students without ID cards are not attending the classes.
2. Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the Campus. The violator would be penalized with a fine of 1000 Rs.
3. Loud Music anywhere on the campus is not permitted. The violator will be fined 250 Rs.
4. Cell Phones must be silent or on vibration within Academic Block Building.
5. Any type of verbal abuse or physical clash or damage caused to CUI property on Campus premises will be reckoned as gross misconduct and will be penalized with a fine of 2000 to 5000 Rs. Further Punishment depends on the nature of the offense.
6. Any comments on notice issued by management placed anywhere on campus are strictly prohibited.
7. Any type of littering anywhere on campus is unacceptable.
8. Eating and Drinking are not allowed in the classrooms.
9. In front of the Director's office, students are not allowed to play any games.
10. Making noises in corridors is highly discouraged.
11. Writing on walls, furniture, or any campus belongings is strictly prohibited and highly offensive.
12. The students are strictly advised against sitting together as couples. Immediate Strong action would be taken against violators. Their University ID cards will be confiscated.
13. The parents of students who violate any of the above-mentioned rules will be informed accordingly.
