## **SEMESTER REPORT SPRING -2021**

### **Talent Hunt Program by Punjab Government**

COMSATS University Islamabad (CUI), Vehari Campus Hosted the "Punjab Talent Hunt" program in which participants from Schools/Colleges/Universities in district Vehari competed in Painting, Crafts, Music and Folk dance.

At the end of the competition, Director COMSATS University Vehari Prof. Dr Saleem Farooq Shaukat and a team from Multan Art Council distributed certificates and prizes among the winners. Students from COMSATS Vehari got 1st positions in Painting and Music, while 2nd and 3rd positions in crafts.



## Anti Women Harassment

Office of Student Affairs (OSA) CUI, Vehari Campus organized an awareness session on “ Anti Women Harassment” Collaboration with Punjab Police district Vehari.

Incharge Anti Women Harassment Cell Vehari, Mr. Adnan Jamil (Sub Inspector) elaborated how to stop gender violence and women harassment. He introduced Women Safety App that helps women in getting immediate and effective response from Punjab police at their precise location.



## Handling a Broad Spectrum of Emergency Situations

A seminar/Demonstration was conducted on the theme of "How to handle a broad spectrum of emergency situations" by OSA's health awareness and blood donation committee, aiming to establish a socially responsible community that can respond to awkward situations and events. The seminar was opened with the recitation of Quran e Kareem followed by an opening note from Dr Ahmad Saeed Khattak. After that, worthy Prof. Dr Saleem Farooq Shoukat briefed the audience on the importance of first aid in one life and stressed the need for such seminars to empower society in tackling their day-to-day life accidents and untoward events. Mr M. Asghar from the Rescue 1122 team then delivered a comprehensive lecture on the procedures for the first aids during various medical scenarios, including Heart Attacks, Bleeding, respiratory blockage, Traffic Accidents, drowning, electric shock, etc., followed by a hands-on demonstration involving the students. Further, students, staff and faculty visited the fully-equipped ambulance of 1122 and were briefed by first aid services during the transportation of the patients. All the audience appreciated the training and were committed to playing their role when and where needed.

### **1. Seminar on “Blood donation: A Boon or Bane? and Blood Camp**

On 11<sup>th</sup> November 2021, an awareness seminar on “Blood donation; a boon or bane?” was arranged by Health awareness and blood donation society under the convenership of Dr. M. Farhan Saeed.
