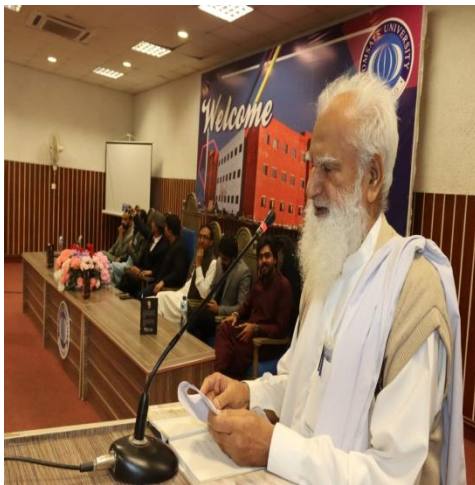


6. Mehfil-e-Mushaira
